Released chukar will be used in all stakes except Open Puppy Classic. Native quail, Hungarian Partridge & pheasants may be present on course. A blank pistol will be fired in all stakes except Open Puppy Classic. Only a blank pistol incapable of firing live ammunition may be used. AKC APPROVED TRACKING COLLARS MAY BE USED IN ALL STAKES. Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes. Rental horses for handlers and spectators are available if requested in advance. Call the wrangler Terry Zygalski to reserve.

Welcome to the 26th annual American Pointer Club National Field Trial Championships

This year the trial will be run at Keith and Bobbi Richardson's Prairie Wind Ranch – Prairie Wind is a beautiful 1600 acre cattle ranch and home to the Region 9 NGSPA championship field trials. The ranch has typical big, rugged hills of the West with rocky outcroppings and is a natural habitat for wild chukars and Hungarian partridge.

Directions to grounds

The Richardson Ranch is 19 miles west of Payette (30 min drive) and is located at 8719 Little Willow Rd, Payette, ID. This spectacular rugged high desert country is close to the Southwest Oregon/Idaho border. Signs will be Posted.

Directions from the North and West

Take I-84 exit 376B for for US 30 e/e Idaho Ave. Continue to follow US 30 E entering Idaho for 1.3 miles. Turn left onto US-95 N/N Whitley Dr. Continue to follow US-95 N for 1.3 miles. Turn right onto ID-52 E for 0.7 miles. Turn slight left onto Little Willow Rd (watch for the Paddock Reservoir sign) and follow it for 13.6 miles to the Richardson Ranch.

Directions from the South and East

Take I-84 exit 9 for US-30 toward New Plymouth for 3.1 miles. Turn right onto ID-72 E for 2 miles. Turn left onto ID-52 W for 7.4 miles. Turn right onto Little Willow Rd and follow it 13.6 miles to the Richardson Ranch.

Fees for the Ranch

Horses: \$2.50 per day per horse (pen or stake out)
Electrical hookups: \$7.50 per day

There are 11 electrical boxes and most can be doubled up by double parking trailers. First come first served. Space must be used wisely. Water hydrants are located around the camp area. The system is on a well so they must not be left running.

Camping

Overnight camping is allowed on the trial grounds. Space is limited so please park and stake out dogs and horses with consideration to others. Event reservation forms are available on arrival must be completed and submitted with fees before you leave.

Please spread/remove horse manure and hay and pick up dog waste.
