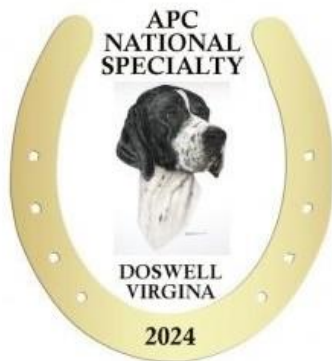

**ENTRIES CLOSE NOON WEDNESDAY, March 13, 2024**, at the office of the Show Secretary, after which time no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, completed or signed, and no entry fees refunded. Telephone and telegraph entries are not accepted. Class changes and cancellations must be received in writing prior to closing date, except as provided for in Chapter 14 Section 6 of the AKC Dog Show Rules. All entry forms must be signed, and photocopies must include the back with the Agreement; otherwise, the entry cannot be accepted and will be returned.

The Show Secretary may not enter any dog at this show, either owned wholly or in part, nor may any member of their family enter a dog at this show.

**New AKC Rule ~ Effective January 1, 2010**

**CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1.** No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.
